January 25th Book Club Reading

For the January 25th Book club we will be reading **White Working Class: Overcoming Class Cluelessness in America** by Joan C. Williams. Joan Williams is a law professor at the University of California, Hastings College of Law. She went to Yale and then Harvard Law School and came from a family she would place in the elite class. The book is an update and expansion of an article she published in the Harvard Business Review, which she wrote on election night 2016.

She focuses on the cultural divide between the working class and the elite class, organizing the book around various questions. The book provides a sympathetic view of the white working class and its values. In the process, it offers a better understanding of and appreciation for the white working class.
